Curriculum Information

English.

The children have now finished our work on The Iron Man by Ted Hughes and have enjoyed writing newspaper reports, diaries and adventure stories. This half term we will be examining Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo and the children will be working on persuasive texts, biographies and more narratives.

Mathematics,

We have had great successes with our work on place value, addition and subtraction already this year. Moving towards the winter break, the children will be focusing on measurement, multiplication and division.
